

Greater BYPY Awards Category Breakdown

The rules:

- These awards are aimed at individuals rather than the businesses themselves.
- There is an age limit of 35 or under (before 18th October 2024).
- Entrants are only permitted to enter one sector award.
- Members of the Future Faces committee are permitted to enter these awards.
- Entrants may not enter a category they won at the Greater BYPY Awards 2023.
- This application form may be completed by an individual on behalf of themselves or someone else on their behalf.
- If your application is successful, you will be invited to an in-person interview on the 2nd September 2024, online interviews will be available due extenuating circumstances.

1. Greater Birmingham Apprentice of the Year

Applicable to those working towards or who have recently completed their apprenticeship within the last 12 months.

2. GBYPY - Creative Arts and Culture

Applicable to those who work within the arts and cultural sector, including entertainment.

3. GBYPY - Digital, Technology & Innovation

Applicable to those in any sector who deliver technological advancements or create innovative solutions through their work.

4. GBYPY – Environmental, Social and Governance

Applicable to those in any sector who are addressing environmental challenges through innovative and sustainable practices and / or projects.

5. GBYPY – Events, Retail and Hospitality

Applicable to those within events, catering and retail venues that deliver high-quality customer service and excellent products. It is open to wholesalers, brick and mortar as well as online-only businesses.

6. GBYPY – Finance

Applicable to those who work within the finance profession or who perform a finance function within their business.

7. GBYPY - Legal

Applicable to those who work within the legal profession or who perform a legal function within their business.

8. GBYPY – Property, Construction and Engineering

Applicable to those in the property, construction, manufacturing, engineering, energy, or other relevant sectors.

9. GBYPY - People and Wellbeing

Applicable to those working within the health, wellbeing, HR, diversity, inclusion and recruitment sector.

10. GBYPY - Sales, Marketing and Communications

Applicable to those in sales, marketing, digital media, events, PR, and other communications roles, either in-house or within a specialist agency.

11. GBYPY - Start-ups, Enterprise and Entrepreneurship

Applicable to those who have started a business within the last 3 years.

12. GBYPY – Not for Profit

Applicable to those working within charities, voluntary and community groups, not for profit organisations and social enterprises. It could also include individuals who work or volunteer for the improvement of society.

13. GBYPY - Training and Education

Applicable to those working in not for profit making organisations, governmental organisations and the education sector and training providers.
